

**St Jude School Commission  
Minutes of the Meeting Held  
March 13, 2007**

The St. Jude School Commission (the "Commission") met on March 13, 2007. The following members of the Commission were present, constituting a quorum: Cheryl McAllen, Chairperson; Mary Ann Chamberlin, Vice-Chairperson; John A. Hovanec, Secretary; Sr. James Michael, Ex-Officio Member and Administrative Officer; Michael Croddy, Member, John Swhear, Member, and Paul Sahn, Member.

The Chairperson opened the meeting at 7:05 pm. She recognized Mr. Hovanec who provided an opening prayer.

The minutes from the previous meeting of the Commission held on February 19, 2007 were approved as amended, having been previously distributed to the members of the Commission.

Mr. Sahn advised the 2007-2008 Kindergarten and Grades 1-8 tuitions will be determined at subsequent meetings upon receipt of necessary financial information. Further, Sister and Mr. Sahn advised that school enrollment was up, six families were leaving the school, but 20 new applications had been received to date.

Mrs. Rohrman recommended to the Commission the Great Lakes SCRIP Program/Fundraiser. The Commission voted and approved the Great Lakes SCRIP Program/Fundraiser proposed by Mrs. Rohrman with tuition assistance.

The Commission voted and approved the following modification to the Teacher Request for PTO Funds form: "PTO Approval" to "PTO President/Vice-President Approval."

Mr. Swhear and the technology committee are considering whether to upgrade the computer lab or upgrade the school's computer technology similar to Roncalli.

Mrs. Chamberlin is pursuing a St. Jude Alumni Association. Mrs. McAllen informed the Commission that advertisements for new Commission members have been sent out and will continue for the following three weeks. Further, the Capital Improvements Campaign is still evaluating all potential options and no final decisions have been made to date.

Mr. Sahn and Mrs. McAllen advised that the Men's Club has agreed to provide \$4,500.00 towards the School security door. The Men's Club will vote on this expense at their next meeting.

Mr. Croddy told the Commission that he should have after-school traffic monitors for each day of the week.

Mrs. Rohrman and Sister James Michael passed out their respective reports with Sister James Michael advising that on March 16 the 6<sup>th</sup> Grade will attend the St. Patrick's Day Parade and Reconciliation for grades 3-8 and the Faery Gold program will all take place; report cards will be given March 21; Spring Break begin Friday, March 23 and classes resume Monday, April 2; and the eighth grad class will be doing the Living Way of the Cross Good Friday, April 6 at 1:00 p.m.

The next meeting is scheduled for April 10, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. There being no further business before the Commission, there was a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded, and the Commission adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
